



TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MEALS

The Philippine Information Agency intends to procure Packed Meals for the 3 Day First Responder Training Course.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The training entails the procurement of Packed Meals for the participants of the 3 Day First Responder Training Course on 2-4 October 2024.

- A. Am Snacks with drinks.
- B. **LUNCH-** 2 Viands (Fish, pork, Beef, Poultry) with vegetable, dish, plain rice, desert and drinks.
- C. Pm Snacks with drinks.

II. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

A. Approved budget for the contract is Fifty- Five Thousand, Two Hundred Pesos only (55,200.00), inclusive of all government taxes and service charges.

IV. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SUPPLIER

- **A.** The Supplier shall provide the food packs with reasonable care, skills and diligence. All goods supplied shall be new and fresh.
- **B.** The Supplier must deliver the food packs following the delivery schedule specified in the above scheduled requirements.
- **C.** tHE supplier must submit the detailed food line up for Am Snacks, Lunch, and Pm Snacks with descriptions as necessary.
- **D.** The supplier shall ensure that the food container and other items must be clean and kept in an hygienic and proper manner at all times.
- **E.** Where food packs are rejected as being damaged, spoiled of otherwise falling to conform to the requirements in these terms, the Supplier shall, at its own cost, remove, replace and re-perform or take such corrective action as may be required to enable the food packs to conform to the requirements and satisfaction of the end-user.

V. TERMS OF PAYMENT

1. The Supplier shall provide the bank account wherein payment will be credited.







VI. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- A. Where the contractor refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the delivery within the specified contract time, plus any extension time duly granted and is hereby in default under the contract, the Contractor shall pay PIA for liquidated damages, and not by way of penalty, an amount as provided in the conditions of the contract equal to the tenth (1/10) of one percent 1% of the cost of the underperformed portion of everyday delay, Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches then percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, The PIA may rescind or terminate the contract without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances such as but not limited to forfeiture of performance security and/or blacklisting of the latter.
- B. For entitlement to such liquidate damages, PIA need not to prove the damages actually incurred. Said damages in any amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due to the Contractor under the contract and /or collect such liquidated damages from the retention money or other securities posted by the service Contractor at the PIA's convenience.
